What is the purpose of this update?

This document tells you how Ethica has performed and what fees were charged. The document will help you to compare the fund with other funds. Smartshares Limited prepared this update in accordance with the Financial Markets Conduct Act 2013. This information is not audited and may be updated.

Description of this fund

Ethica is a socially responsible fund that invests in a balanced mix of income and growth assets. Excludes assets that do not meet ethical investment standards. Negative annual returns may occur once in every 5 – 7 years on average.

What are the risks of investing?

Risk indicator for Ethica



The risk indicator is rated from 1 (low) to 7 (high). The rating reflects how much the value of the fund's assets goes up and down. A higher risk generally means higher potential returns over time, but more ups and downs along the way.

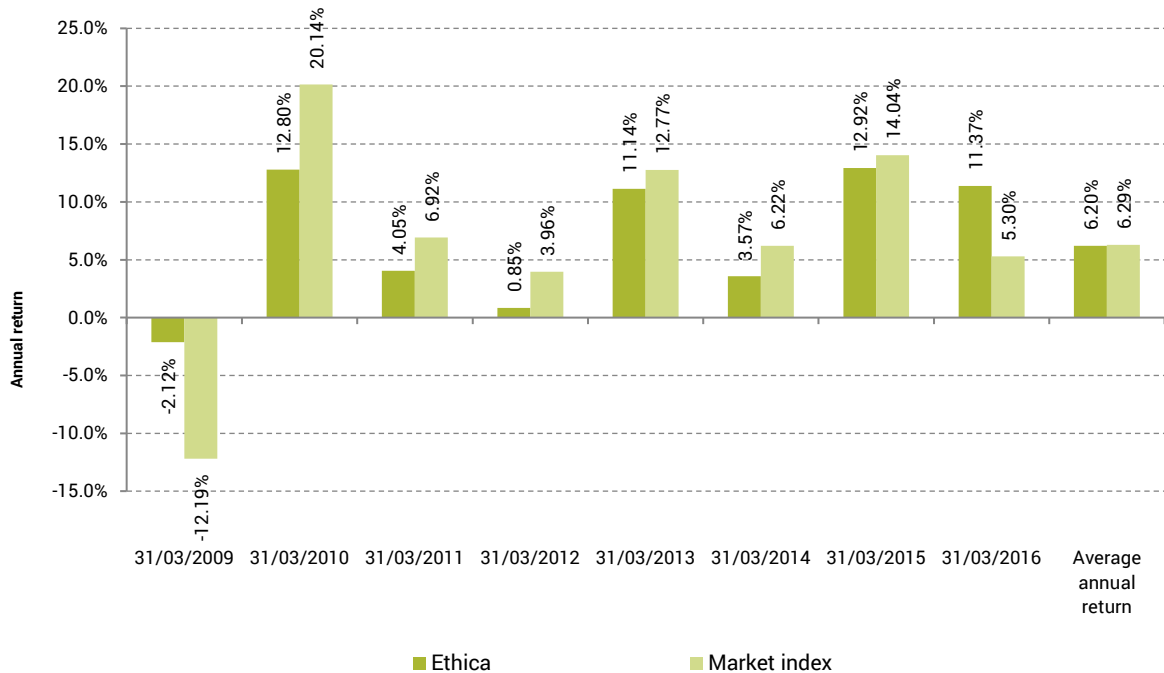

How has the fund performed?

Annual return graph



This shows the return after fund charges and tax for each year ending 31 March since the fund started. The last bar shows the average annual return since the fund started, up to 31 December 2016.

What fees are investors charged?

Investors in Ethica are charged fund charges. In the year to 31 March 2016 these were:

The supplement for your employer may allow you to withdraw money from your member account and transfer it to a KiwiSaver scheme. Where the transfer is to a KiwiSaver scheme other than the SuperLife KiwiSaver scheme, you may be charged a withdrawal fee. The fee is \$50.

*From 9 November 2016, the total fund charges changed to an estimated 0.59% per annum of the fund's net asset value and the administration fee reduced to \$12 per annum. A paper statement fee of \$18 per annum was introduced.

Small differences in fees and charges can have a big impact on your investment over the long term.

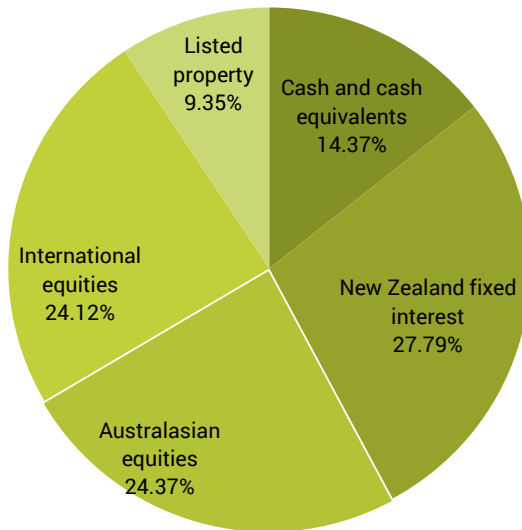
Example of how this applies to an investor

Jess had \$10,000 in the fund at the start of the year and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Jess received a return after fund charges were deducted of \$462 (that is 4.62% of her initial \$10,000). Jess paid other charges of \$31 (Jess received statements and other SuperLife communications electronically and was not charged the paper statements fee). This gives Jess a total return after tax of \$462 for the year.
