

# KiwiSaver – what is in it for me?

#### Employees earning \$34,762 a year


KiwiSaver is about securing a better future. Whether it is to save a deposit for a house or for your ultimate retirement, you can generally save more in KiwiSaver than in alternative investment products.

Example<sup>1</sup> - pay = \$669 a week (\$34,762 a year)

### After 1 year, the position is:

\$1,043	i.e. \$20 a week
+\$ 521	50 cents for \$1 up to \$10 a week i.e. \$521 for a full year
+\$ 860	Employers pay 3% less tax
+\$ 47	(Say 5% after-tax)
- <u>\$ 33</u>	You pay \$1,043 and after 1 year have \$2,438
= \$2,438	- where else can you more than double your money with little risk?
	+\$ 521 +\$ 860 +\$ 47 -\$ 33

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> Assumes that you earn \$34,762 a year. If you earn less than \$34,762, your contributions will be lower. If you earn more, your contributions will be higher. If you are <u>not</u> an employee, you can choose how much you save - the 3% does not apply and there is no employer subsidy.
